The response submittal must include the following:

Letter of Interest (2 page limit)

Statement of Qualifications (10 page limit)

Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020).

DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at www.modot.gov, in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any project they feel can be managed by their firm. The DBE goal for this Engineering Services Contract will be 8%.

It is required that your firm be prequalified with MoDOT and listed in MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List, or your firm will be considered non-responsive.

We request all submittals be received by 5:00 pm, Friday, February 26, 2016 at City of Columbia Public Works Department, 3rd Floor, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri 65025.
