- Why your firm is best suited to accomplish the consulting work for this project

A current Statement of Qualifications for your firm is required to be submitted with your letter of interest or be on file with the Franklin County Highway Department.

It is required that your firm be prequalified with MoDOT and listed on MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List or your firm will be considered non-responsive.

Overview

Local communities and entities along the Route 47 corridor from Washington to St. Clair are interested in having a traffic study and analysis performed on Missouri Route 47 from Washington, Missouri to St. Clair, Missouri. It is desired the successful consultant will be able to perform in depth traffic and accident study analysis to formulate improvements that can be undertaken to improve traffic flow, reduce congestion and improve safety. The successful consultant will provide a study outlining the information obtained, the analysis performed and the recommendations on any improvements that can be undertaken immediately, intermediary and long term.

The Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) owns and maintains Missouri Route 47 and will be a partner with the participating local agencies in reviewing the study, analysis and proposed improvements. Proposed improvements, both immediately, intermediary and long term will need to be approved by MODOT.

The recommendations will include an estimated timetable for implementation of the recommended improvements as well as an estimated cost of implementation. It is also desired the recommended improvements include a detailed report on the permitting required and the agencies that would be involved with the various permitting. If approvals are needed for a recommended improvement the report shall contain the agencies from which approval is needed.
