DBE firms must be listed in the MRCC DBE Directory located on MoDOT's website at www.modot.gov, in order to be counted as participation towards an established DBE Goal. We encourage DBE firms to submit letters of interest as prime consultants for any project they feel can be managed by their firm.

It is required that your firm's Statement of Qualification (RSMo 8.285 through 8.291) and an Affidavit of Compliance with the federal work authorization program along with a copy of your firm's E-Verify Memorandum of Understanding (15 CSR 60-15.020) be submitted with your firm's Letter of Interest. It is also required that your firm be prequalified with MoDOT and listed in MoDOT's Approved Consultant Prequalification List.

We request all letters be received by 10:00 a.m., March 29, 2013 at in the Saline County Commission's Office, 19 East Arrow Street, Room 101, Marshall, MO 65340.
