**GENERAL CLARIFICATIONS:**

The lateral field's loam fill will be compacted to 85% of maximum dry density within 2% of the optimum moisture content as determined by ASTM D698. Maximum dry density will be determined by the standard proctor analysis method defined by ASTM D698. A minimum of one compaction test per lateral line will be required. It shall be the responsibility of the Contractor to have the Proctor test and the compaction tests performed by a certified soil testing laboratory to verify the required compaction has been achieved.

**SEEDING AND MULCHING:**

- A. Fertilizing:
1. Commercial Fertilizer: Fertilizers shall be applied at the following rates:
    - (a) Nitrogen 80 lb. per acre
    - (b) Phosphate 150 lb. per acre
    - (c) Potash 80 lb. per acre
- B. Seeding: Seed shall be Kentucky 31 fescus (or equivalent) to be applied at a rate of 400 lb. per acre.
- C. Mulching: The mulch shall be Type 1 mulch as per Specification Section 802 of the Missouri Standard Specifications for Highway Construction.



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
