1. Page 4- Determination of award in March 2010- what is the revised date? **Late April 2010.**
2. Page 4- Fiscal Year- October 1 – September 30 – will this run 2010-2011? **No. The fiscal year will be October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2010.**
3. Page 5- Attaining full or part-time employment by September 30, 2010- is there a revised date? **No, September 30, 2010 is the correct date.**
4. Page 7- Performance Period- October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2010- what are the revised dates? **There are no revised dates, October 1, 2009 to September 30, 2010 is correct.**
5. Is this program limited to out of school participants requiring GED preparation? Or, do you mean a GED component must be made available, if needed? **The GED component should be made available if the student does not have a GED or high school diploma.**
