Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans for bridge improvements at Route UU over the Sugar Branch Creek and Route E over Perche Creek and Rocky Fork Creek.

What work is being done to the bridges?

Work on the Rocky Fork Creek and Perche Creek Bridges on Route E will involve removing and replacing the existing decks of the bridges. The new bridge decks will include new concrete barrier curb as well as guardrail. The new bridge decks will also be wider with 24 feet wide driving surfaces versus their existing 22 foot widths. The Sugar Branch Creek Bridge on Route UU will be completely replaced. The new bridge will include new concrete barrier curb and guardrail and will be 28 feet wide which is 8 feet wider than the existing bridge.

How will traffic be affected?

All three bridges will be closed during construction. Detour routes will be signed along state routes.

When will the work take place?

Both projects are scheduled to be awarded in the spring of 2015, with construction tentatively scheduled to take place in the spring and summer of 2015.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

No. All work will be done within existing state right of way.

What will the projects cost?

The current cost for the Rocky Fork Creek and Perche Creek Bridge project on Route E is \$1.2 million. The current cost for the Sugar Branch Creek Bridge project on Route UU is \$600,000.
