Frequently Asked Questions

What is the purpose of tonight's meeting?

The purpose of tonight's meeting is to provide information on plans to overlay Route 50 between east of Route 100 and east of Route 89 in Linn. The proposed work will also include the construction of four foot paved shoulders in some areas. The pedestrian facilities on MoDOT Right of Way will be upgraded to meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

How will traffic be affected?

Occasional temporary lane and entrance closures are possible in the work area during the project.

When will the work take place?

The project is scheduled to be awarded in Spring of 2015, with construction tentatively scheduled to take place in the summer.

Will additional right of way be needed to construct this project?

No. However, temporary construction easement acquisition on adjoining property may be necessary.

What will the project cost?

The total project cost is approximately \$800,000.
